- Send for AED - Located in Room 15 - Staff Workroom
- Send for Administrator to assume "Leader" role. If an administrator cannot be located, the head coach will be the "Leader".

Leader:

- This person will be in charge of the emergency and will instruct others on the emergency team accordingly.
- This person will fully document the incident and all actions taken.

Leader's Assistant:

- This person will assist the "Leader" in the primary evaluation of the emergency.

Phone Caller (a designated adult with access to school phone or personal cell phone):

- Call EMS 911 and communicate the following information-
 - The nature of the injury;
 - Level of consciousness;
 - Age/sex of injured; and
 - Caller will not hang up until EMS operator has advised to do so.
- Note: Dial 8 on any school phone to reach outside line, then dial 911.
- Note: School phones are located in all classrooms, hallways, and gymnasiums.

Person to Meet EMS:

- Will contact necessary staff to assure full access for ambulance.
- Will meet the ambulance at the designated entrance and lead them to site of the emergency.

Person to Accompany to Hospital:

- Will ride in the ambulance in the event the parent/guardian cannot be contacted.
- Will take student's emergency information to the hospital if possible.
